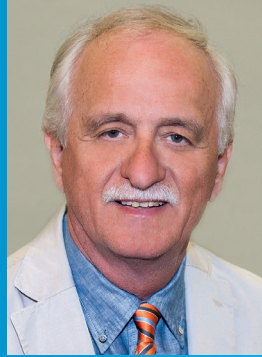

Dear Colleagues,

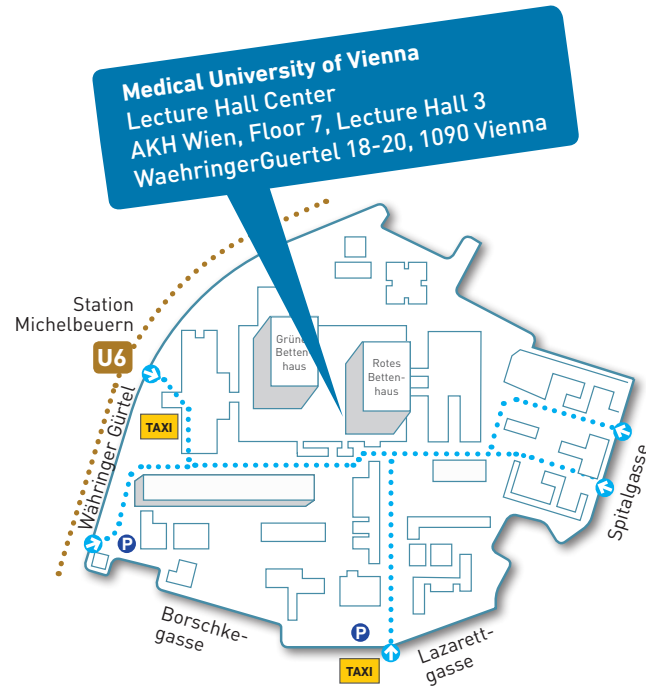

We would like to welcome you in Vienna for these interesting and exiting two days. Enjoy the spirit of the city and obtain a very special information.

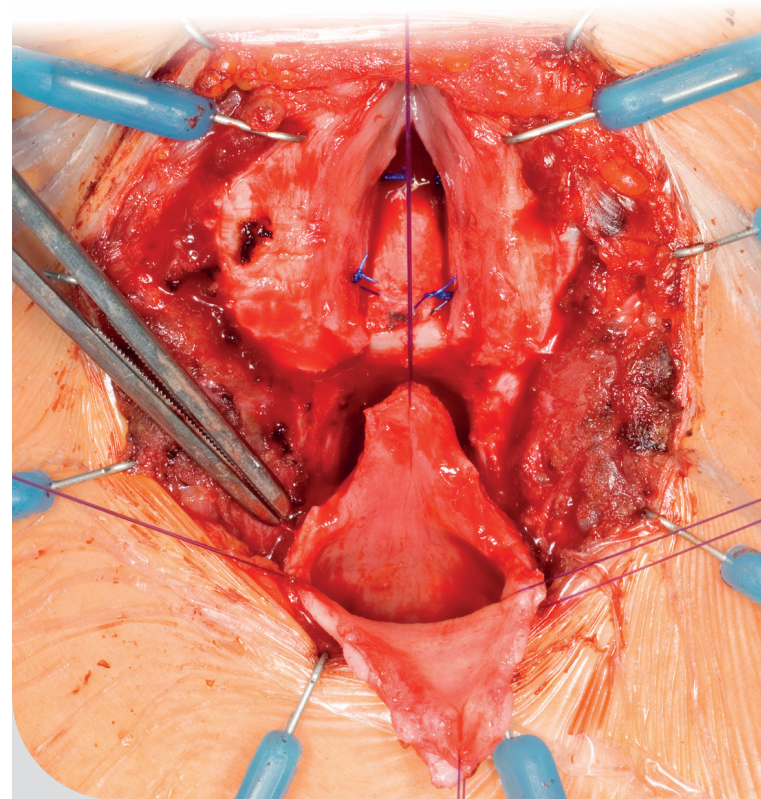
