



**The World Tour is intended to spread knowledge in the fields of head and neck surgery, radiotherapy and medical oncology around the world. In 2016 IFHNOS is again proposing this global continuing medical education program aimed at all physicians involved in head and neck cancer care, including otolaryngologists, oncologists / radiotherapists, maxillofacial and general surgeons.**

The program will provide state-of-the-art knowledge and explore the frontiers of head and neck cancer diagnosis and treatment through introductory lectures, intense interactive discussions with regional specialists with case presentations and demonstration of operative techniques through video sessions.

Regional leaders in the specialty will join the traveling faculty for each scientific session which will allow intellectual exchange and a balanced view of the variances in current practices in the management of head and neck tumors.
